First Aid/ Emergencies

It is best to use any house phone and dial 76911. This will direct the call to the Mirage Security Emergency Center where appropriate action will be initiated. To call local emergency services VIA 911, dial the hotel operator and ask to be connected to the local, non-hotel, 911 operators. The number from an outside line is 702.791.7175.

All Mirage Security Officers are trained on basic first aid, including CPR and use of automated external defibrillators (AEDs). A medical provider card, listing several options for medical services is available upon request. WPPI has hired an additional EMT/Medic who will be onsite and can be found at Registration Desk 3.

Mainstage Location: St. Croix Mainstage Etiquette:

A line will form outside of St. Croix AB in the morning before 8am, Sunday-Monday so if you want a front row seat, please plan ahead. Your seat will remain your seat for all talks that day.

Attendees cannot save spots in line for their friends, nor can attendees save seats for anyone if they want to sit with a group. If you wish to sit with a group, the entire group must be present and together in line.

Shooting Bay Avenue

Shooting Bay Avenue: You will also want to bring your camera so that you can take part in the shooting bays and build your portfolio. The shooting bays are designed for beginner photographers all the way to expert photographers—there will be shooting bay attendants present to help you get some beautiful shots for your portfolio!

We will have dedicated Shooting Bays exclusive to TPM Conference Pass holders (called The Playground) that is separate from the rest of WPPI's shooting bays, so you have more time to build your portfolio!

How To Book: Image Reviews and Mentor Sessions are available on a first-come, first-serve basis, with walk-ins only. These will be held during the WPPI conference on the show floor Tuesday - Thursday only.

SHOOT & SHOP ETIQUETTE

Attendees cannot save spots in any of the lines for their friends in the Shoot & Shop area. Attendees must be respectful of all other attendees, staff, models, mentors, vendors and hotel staff at all times.

While in a shooting bay, only one person will photograph the model at a time. When multiple people try to photograph the model, you're potentially distracting the model and the photographer who's turn it is to shoot. You can take BTS for the photographer who's turn it is to photograph the model, but please do not shoot over their shoulder. Respect their time.

Attendees may not touch models, or photograph them outside of a shooting bay or touch lights in the shooting bays.

Should anyone witness any line jumping or seat saving, please do not confront the individual/s—alert the nearest staff member. We want everyone to have a safe, hospitable experience at our talks and anyone who does not act in accordance with these guidelines may be asked to leave the event.

PACKING & ATTIRE

We recommend that you bring layers—while it can be very hot outside during the day, the AC indoors can be a bit too much for people sensitive to cold. It can also get cool in the evenings.

We are encouraging everyone to dress "cocktail party" for the Sunday evening Portrait Masters Awards Celebration, and 'Vegas Glam' for Monday's Silent Disco and Tuesday's Karaoke.

For the Closing Party, anything goes as long as it is tasteful. Make sure to bring a couple pairs of comfortable shoes and bandaids if you get blisters!

WELLBEING & SAFETY

Start hydrating before you arrive—if you are not familiar with Vegas weather, hydration is extremely important. Along with water, we recommend supplementing with electrolytes (coconut water, sports drinks, or electrolyte packets) and be mindful of your caffeine and alcohol intake.


